



QUICK-START GUIDE

Rat Zapper *ULTRA IR (Infrared)*

Open the Battery Compartment:

The **Rat Zapper *Ultra IR*** battery compartment is located on the top of the unit. To open, pull the securing tab back then lift the battery compartment door. Properly install 4 “D” batteries in the battery holder and re-secure the lid to the battery compartment.

Important Information: The performance of your **Rat Zapper *Ultra IR*** will depend upon the:

1. Quality of batteries;
2. Amount of time your **Rat Zapper *Ultra IR*** is turned on;
3. Number of rodents killed;
4. Cleanliness of the unit floor.

Rating	Battery Type	Expected Use
GOOD	Quality Alkaline Batteries	These batteries should provide approximately 100 kills or more than a year of standby power.
NO!	Heavy Duty, Super Heavy Duty, Extra Heavy Duty, Carbon Zinc, non alkaline	Are <i>not</i> recommended for the Rat Zapper <i>Ultra IR</i>
NO!	NiCad (Nickel Cadmium) or NMH Rechargeables	Are <i>not</i> recommended for the Rat Zapper <i>Ultra IR</i>

What do the green and red lights on the Rat Zapper *Ultra IR* mean?

GREEN LIGHT:

Battery Check- When you turn the **Rat Zapper *Ultra IR*** power switch to the **ON** position, the green light will blink once, then turn off. This tells you the battery quality is good and all systems are “go”. After a short, three second delay to allow your Rat Zapper electronics to check status, if the green light does not turn on at all or there is a rapid blinking red light, replace the batteries. (See chart above for Recommended Batteries.)

RED LIGHT:

Rodent Check- The **Rat Zapper *Ultra*** red kills indicator light will blink **repeatedly** when you’ve killed a rodent. For a guide to what the various red and green lights signify please refer to the instructions located behind the ON/OFF switch of your Rat Zapper.

Baiting The Trap-Dry dog or cat food makes an excellent bait. Just slide one or two pieces all the way into the rear of the Zapper. You may want to experiment, but avoid moist or wet baits that may contaminate the metal plates and cause the unit to stop operating.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING (Remove batteries first!)

When dust, dirt or other contaminants accumulate in the **Rat Zapper Ultra IR**, you will need to clean the unit.

1. Remove batteries before cleaning to insure safety.
2. Obtain an inexpensive, thin aluminum pan large enough in width and length to accommodate the **Rat Zapper Ultra IR**.
3. Fill the pan with approximately 2 inches of warm water along with a small amount of dish detergent. Set the **Rat Zapper Ultra IR** in the pan and let it soak for approximately 1 hour (to loosen debris.)
4. Using a soft bristle or bottlebrush commonly found in the cookware section of your local supermarket, gently brush the bottom of your **Rat Zapper Ultra IR**.
5. To rinse, carefully allow a gentle stream of fresh water to flow over the cleaned bottom surface of the **Rat Zapper Ultra IR**. Do not spray the unit out or allow moisture to intrude into the electronics that are housed at the top of the unit as this may cause the electronics to short out and impair the unit's performance.
6. After cleaning and rinsing the bottom of the **Rat Zapper Ultra IR** thoroughly allow the water to drain and let your **Rat Zapper Ultra IR** air dry completely (do not use air compressor) before putting it back into service.

TO MINIMIZE THE CHANCE OF FALSE TRIPS AND DAMAGE TO THE ELECTRONICS

- For continuous use outdoors purchase a **Rat Zapper Rat's Nest** (Our *Rat's Nest* housing is designed to protect your **Rat Zapper Ultra IR** from water and other elements).
- A temporary solution for the outdoor use of the **Rat Zapper Ultra IR** is to place it under a weatherproof-tarp, or cover it with a similar water-proof cover, leaving only the entry uncovered.
